On June 21, 2024, President Biden issued Proclamation 10779, ending the exemption from Section 201 duties on bifacial solar panels imported on or after June 26 at 12:01 a. With the exemption removed, bifacial solar cells/panels will now be subject to Section 201 duties.

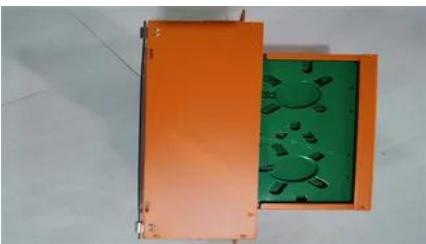
