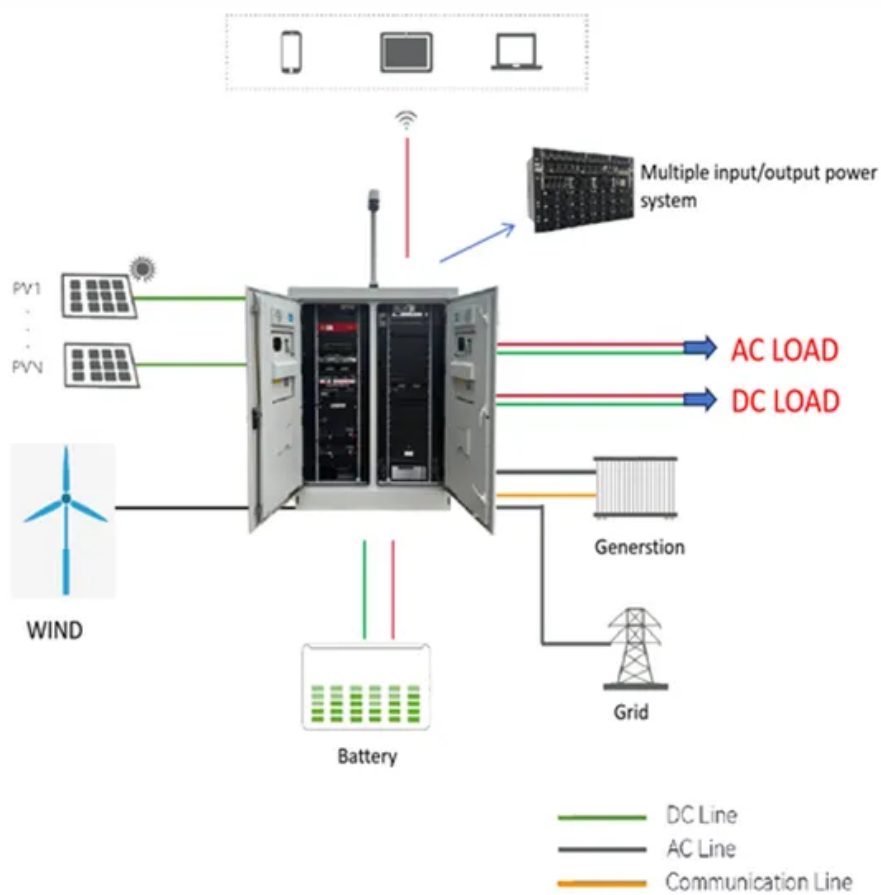


Somaliland electricity generation

Somaliland's current electricity production is limited, decentralized, and heavily reliant on imported diesel fuel. Estimates vary, but the total installed capacity across Somaliland hovers around 60 to 80 megawatts (MW) -a tiny fraction of what the population actually needs.
